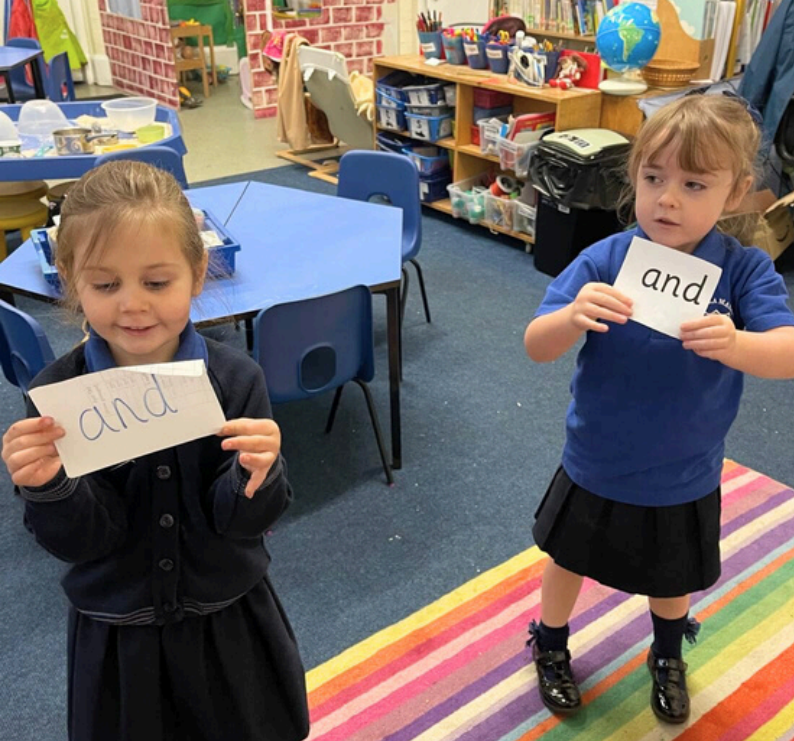
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CLASS NEWS

Pre-Prep

We've had a great week starting with some super skating on Monday, some super singing on Tuesday, some dreamy dancing on Wednesday, and some perfect painting on Thursday. On Friday, we are finishing our bear posters, which are already looking great and grizzly!

Year 4/5

Our week began with an exciting trip to the Manchester ice-skating rink, which provided excellent inspiration for our literacy work on writing detailed recounts. The children made great progress, improving the structure of their paragraphs and using descriptive vocabulary to capture the sights, sounds, and sensations of the day. Their final pieces were vivid and engaging records of a memorable experience. In mathematics, we focused on developing our fraction skills, moving from simple recognition to practical calculations. The class learned how to find fractions of amounts—such as $\frac{3}{4}$ of 24—with growing confidence, building important foundations for future work on ratios, percentages, and problem-solving.

Year 1/2

The children in Year 1–2 have had a lovely week. On Monday they enjoyed a fun trip to Manchester for ice skating and pizza, returning to school happily tired. In Maths, they revised 2D and 3D shapes, and in PSHE they learned about feelings and the importance of brushing their teeth twice a day, each receiving a toothbrush and toothpaste. In English, they wrote a recount of their ice-skating trip, and they continue to enjoy our class story - Mog.

Year 6

After all of the fun in Manchester on Monday, the students in Year 6 needed to make up for some lost time! They have been working hard on Geometry and Division in Maths, continuing with creative story writing in English and bringing their performance poetry to life in their Drama class. They managed to fit in a bit of fitness in P.E, decorating Greek clay vases in Art and extra exam practice revision sessions with Mr Usher. They have also enjoyed taking home the C.S. Lewis classic-The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe. If they continue to work hard, they're hoping to go and see a live performance of the story at The Lowry in December!
