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CLASS NEWS

Pre-Prep

Our class has started work in our special phonics books, learning to hear the sounds in words and beginning to blend sounds together. We also made some spooky skeleton art using chalk and black paper.

We enjoyed helping out at the toddler group, where there was a dinosaur theme this week. At Forest School, we enjoyed a fire for toasting marshmallows and popping popcorn.

Year 4/5

In History, we have seen significant progress in our students' understanding of Ancient Greece. They explored Ancient Greek architecture and created impressive drawings of the Parthenon in Athens. This work was a culmination of our recent Art lessons, where they mastered the art of drawing Doric columns in chalk.

Our Geography lessons have been an exciting journey through the seven Continents of the Earth. To aid their learning, students have been using atlases and the Chromebook to locate the provinces and capital cities of Canada. This blend of traditional and modern learning tools has been instrumental in their understanding of Geography.

Year 1/2

It's been another fun-filled week of learning for Year 1 and 2! In Maths, the children confidently revised addition and subtraction, with everyone scoring brilliantly in their mini assessment. In English, they explored poetry, learning about rhythm and rhyme before writing a lovely class poem all about Autumn.

PSHE lessons focused on understanding and expressing feelings, while in French, the children enjoyed learning the days of the week.

During Phonics, they revised Phase 5 tricky words and discovered how contractions work.

Year 6

It's been another busy week of learning in Year 6. In Maths, the children have been revising square, prime and cube numbers as well as starting a new topic on area and perimeter. In English, they have written about their dreams and ambitions for the future. During their Drama lesson they have been looking really closely at how the poet uses punctuation to control the pace at which a poem is read aloud. The P.E lesson was all about dribbling a ball closely with their feet before turning and passing through a target. The children are ready for a rest this weekend!
