Pre-Prep

Another fun week in Pre-Prep! We enjoyed looking for 'mini-beasts' at Forest School on Monday, learnt a very spooky song on Tuesday, and made windmill models on Wednesday. On Thursday, we were busy helping at the school's new 'Stay and Play' group. We feel ready for a rest now!

Year 4/5

The children have had another productive week and are adapting well to new routines across the class and school, growing in confidence as they settle in.

In Mathematics, they have begun using the Power Maths books, which help them revisit key concepts while applying their knowledge through problem-solving. This has kept lessons engaging and interactive.

In English, pupils have been refining their descriptive writing about a lighthouse in a storm. After responding to feedback, they published their final versions on Chromebooks. Hearing each other's imaginative stories has inspired a great sense of creativity across the class.

Year 1/2

This week in English, the children completed their work on Fantasy Stories and wrote book reviews of their favourite story from the three we explored together.

In Maths, they continued building their skills with addition and subtraction, tackling challenges with enthusiasm.

PE was full of fun as the class enjoyed a lively Gymnastics session in the Hall!

In Religion, the children learned about the Gospel value of Justice, which Mr Usher introduced during Assembly, sparking thoughtful discussions in class.

Year 6

The children in Year 6 have been really busy this week! During their Art lesson they used watered down coffee granules to demonstrate that they could show light and dark shades whilst painting an Ancient Greek temple. During English lessons, they learnt to adapt their creative stories from the 1st person into the 3rd person. Maths lessons focused upon addition and subtraction of numbers up to 10 million and

applying these skills to real life problems. The children continue to work hard on some past papers related to their forthcoming entrance examinations.
